Reminder List

Do neighbours and/or friends know how they can contact your family if you can no longer make contact yourself?

If your family need to sort out your affairs they will be grateful for:

- Access to your home - do they know where to find a key?
- Passwords to find the information on your computer and mobile phone. Have you given someone you trust a password list?
- Your financial records - your bank, investments, pension, insurance policies, your will. Have you compiled a list with names and details?
- Details of the companies that supply you – gas, electricity, broadband, phone and any other services that will need to be dealt with.
- Some indication of who else you would like told? Is there a list of email and postal addresses for them to use?

Hopefully these details will not be needed but at a time when we are frequently reminded to wash our hands and sneeze into our elbows it seemed worth taking things a little further. A step further is arranging Powers of Attorney.
